Per Article 24-302 E (1), subparagraph (e) of the Village Zoning Law the minimum side setback shall be five (5) feet. This property is zoned Residential District.

The shed was built in 1999 and backs up to a neighbors shed and can't be seen from the street. His neighbors have already received a variance for their shed. Mr. Steiner would like to obtain the Area Variance so that if they ever decide to sell the property this will be taken care of.
